## CONDITIONS FOR THE 2010 SPEEDHORSE RACES

Nominations and eligibility for races 1 and 2 are open to horses which are registered with the American Quarter Horse Association, and by a Stallion who paid a participation fee or donated a breeding. ALSO ELIGIBLE entries are those entries which pay an additional \$350.00 per entry, and are by a stallion which did not pay the participation fee or donate a breeding. Dead or pensioned stallions that have met all other requirements may be made eligible by paying \$500. The \$350.00 additional fee for ALSO ELIGIBLE STALLIONS is not to be confused with the stallion participation fee and must be paid for each entry by that stallion. Entries by ELIGIBLE STALLIONS need not pay any additional fees other than the specified payments unless due notice was given that such sire was ineligible. All such ineligible nominators will be advised in writing and their nomination fees returned. Nominations or subscriptions to these races may be refused or cancelled without liability to Speedhorse, Inc., Speedhorse Races, Inc. or the track at which said race is run. Entries must be received time prior to the actual running thereof, except for the return of any entry which is currently active participant at that specific time. Speedhorse Races, Inc. may cancel or postpone any race for any reason which it deems good and sufficient. It reserves the right to, at its own discretion, transfer the races to any racetrack and to change the date of the race/races. Paint and Appaloosa entries do not have any stallion eligibility restrictions. (Paints must have one Regular Registered Paint parent). Speedhorse may at its discretion change race conditions in order to comply with current State Racing Commission Association requirements. Stallion owners and/or farms which donated breeding stock to be sold in the Speedhorse auctions or paid a participation fee are responsible for the stallion(s) progeny eligible for that year's races as well as for the care and maintenance of breeding sels. No other contractual obligation exists.

Speedhorse Races, Inc. for simplicity, is named by used to identify this group of races in these conditions, although each race is a separate corporation for your protection as well as the protection of funds in Federally insured banks.

The following is a list of the Corporation's 2010 Speedhorse Races:  
1) 350 YARD SPEEDHORSE GOLD & SILVER CUP FUTURITY-RG1 (Speedhorse Races, Inc.)  
2) 350 YARD SPEEDHORSE GOLD & SILVER CUP SPRINT DERBY-RG3 (Speedhorse Races, Inc.)  
3) 350 YARD SPEEDHORSE PAINT & APPALOOSA SPRINT FUTURITY-G1 (Speedhorse Races, Inc.)  
4) 350 YARD SPEEDHORSE PAINT & APPALOOSA SPRINT DERBY-G1 (Speedhorse Races, Inc.)

The ten fastest horses will run in the finals of each race (see above). Speedhorse Races, Inc. reserves the right to divide each of these races, including both the added monies and all fees in the event there is a greater number of starters than the track can accommodate. Speedhorse Races, Inc. reserves the right to start any race with or without stall gate starting machine. No horse will be allowed to enter who is not in good standing at the time of the actual running of the race. It is hereby understood that neither Speedhorse, Inc. nor Speedhorse Races, Inc. shall be liable for, and that the owners and lessees of the horse will indemnify and hold harmless Speedhorse, Inc. and/or Speedhorse Races, Inc. and any of the above mentioned entities against all responsibility or liability or claim for injury or damage to any person, horse or other property of the undersigned, or of any other person or his or their agents, employees or associates, caused by the horse or the agent or employee of the undersigned, or by any person, whether by negligence or otherwise, on the premises of the racetrack. The subscriber, for himself, his agents and assigns, hereby assigns to Speedhorse Races, Inc. and/or Speedhorse, Inc., etc. any and all rights in and to the pictures, television and radio broadcasting in connection with this race.

Nominations and sustaining payments any owner may reinstate his entry(s) eligibility by paying a per entry payment of twice the regular fee over the prescribed deadline. The regular payment must be made prior to the next scheduled payment. If two consecutive payments are missed then the entry will be ineligible, although you may reenter with late penalties. The regular entry payment schedule and late payment schedule are printed elsewhere. There are no late penalties on sustaining payments for any reason. Sustaining payments total \$1,750 in race number 1 and \$1,500 in race number 3 and \$1,250 in race number 4.

Ownership, every new owner shall be responsible for timely sustaining payments. Speedhorse Races, Inc., etc. of this change. The filing of this notice of change of ownership shall in no way impair the original nominator's claim to the race for other awards if applicable.

Stallion owners for each race - see purse disbursement elsewhere. The stallion owner of the ELIGIBLE STALLIONS who were made eligible by paying the stallion participation fee, donating a breeding which must sell. ALSO ELIGIBLE STALLIONS are not eligible for the stallion awards.

Stallions shall be owned and be paid to the legal owner(s) or legal lessee(s) of the stallion. Lessee(s) must provide legal documentation by certified mail prior to the race. Award(s) being paid to parties that owe Speedhorse, Inc. or Speedhorse Races, Inc. the amount of that debt deducted from the award. (Even if the Stallion Award will be applied to the debt if the Stallion Owner owned the stallion and/or the advertising was placed regardless of any other arrangement.)

This form will be divided as specified for each race. Speedhorse Races, Inc. may divide additional added monies as it deems best. ALSO ELIGIBLE entries which have offspring nominated to the races at the additional fee of \$350 per entry are eligible for Stallion Awards and the fee will be used toward the purchase of awards and/or kept for administrative fees. See distribution schedule elsewhere.  
Purse Distribution:  
1st - 38% 2nd - 17% 3rd - 11% 4th - 8% 5th - 6% 6th - 5% 7th - 4.5% 8th - 3.5% 9th - 3.0%

Stallion progeny eligible for only the year of the Breeding Donation. Stallion owners or participation fees are to be used for added money by Speedhorse Races, Inc. for administrative costs at Speedhorse Races, Inc. own discretion.

Speedhorseman's Group will be responsible for their portion of the added money. Racing World Inc. will be responsible for their portion of the added money. Speedhorse Races, Inc. etc. accept no responsibility for these funds. Speedhorse Races, Inc. will retain all interest plus 14.9% of the gross total purses (excluding added money) for these races as cost for advertising and administration. Credit Card payments will be applied plus a 3.5% service charge. If any race is cancelled for any reason, Speedhorse Races, Inc. will retain the 14.9% Administrative Fee.

In the event that any entry passes through the entry box and is declared by the Racing Officials after scratch-time, entry shall be entitled to receive tenth place money as a special equity award in lieu of any other award's, return of fees, etc. except where the entry is declared by the Racing Officials for violations of the law or rules of racing. In that event, the purse money shall go to the winner.

Stallion Awards will be deducted from the purse and disbursed at the same rate as the purse disbursement as shown above based on 8% of the total purse for each individual race. If offspring from ALSO ELIGIBLE STALLIONS are included in the finals the stallions in question shall not receive any awards and those awards will be kept for administrative costs by the Speedhorse Races, Inc..

Resolution of disputes. It is recognized that Speedhorse, Inc. has established the rules and conditions for participation in Speedhorse awards in Speedhorse, Inc. sponsored races and contests. By participating in these races and contests, the participant agrees to be bound by rules and conditions as established by Speedhorse, Inc./Speedhorse Races, Inc. In the event of a dispute, the matter governing the award of prizes, awards and monies, the decision of Speedhorse Races, Inc. shall be final, binding and not subject to the court of law. In the event a lawsuit is filed, the parties hereto agree to a RIGHT TO A JURY TRIAL concerning any controversy between the parties' dealings with each other, whether in connection with any AND ALL DISPUTES TO ARBITRATION. The arbitration shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Uniform Arbitration Act found at 15 O.S. §804, B. and, specifically pursuant to the provisions of 15 O.S. §804, B. Speedhorse Races, Inc. may apply to the Court for an order of arbitration in the sole discretion of the Court, of a single arbitrator which said arbitrator shall decide a dispute in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Uniform Arbitration Act. A participant agrees that in the event of an unsuccessful lawsuit, the costs and attorney fees for Speedhorse Races, Inc./Speedhorse Races, Inc. costs and attorneys fees also agrees (a) that the futurity and other contests described herein are a reasonable relationship to the state of Oklahoma; (b) that the rules and conditions should be governed by the laws of the state of Oklahoma in the event of a dispute. Cleveland County, Oklahoma shall be the choice of venue. In the event of a dispute, the current owner of each eligible entry to make timely payments to the nominator. Neither Speedhorse, Inc. nor Speedhorse Races, Inc. accepts responsibility for providing any notice of deadlines or eligibility to any nominator or owner. Any notice provided by Speedhorse, Inc. or Speedhorse Races, Inc. is only for the convenience of the nominator or owner. Failure to mail or receive any notice shall in no way absolve the current owner from ultimate responsibility to insure timely payment(s). Speedhorse Races, Inc. may provide payment reminder notices, eligibility lists or any other notice but Speedhorse, Inc. or Speedhorse Races, Inc. is under no obligation to do so.

The Speedhorse Gold and Silver Cup races are merely proposed races which may or may not be run at the discretion of Speedhorse, Inc. The proposed races should be considered only as a bonus to stallion advertisers and no part of stallion advertising expense should be placed with Speedhorse, Inc. with the expectation that the races will be run. Advertisers are purchasing advertising space only and no separate contractual right exists to demand that a race be conducted. Advertisers will therefore hold Speedhorse, Inc. and Speedhorse Races, Inc. harmless from any damages for cancellation of said races.

The decision of the Stewards of the race shall be final and binding on the condition that these persons nominating and/or starting a horse in the trials or any race agree to abide by their decision.
